He served as a design director for Walt Disney Imagineering for 22 years, where he conceived ideas that were later realized as attractions and theme parks worldwide. Tim Kirk is now the design director for Kirk Designs where he applies his vast experience to the areas of creative content, concepts and art direction.

Before becoming an Imagineer, Tim was a freelance illustrator for children's books and science fiction books and magazines, winning five prestigious Hugo awards as a fan artist. He has also won Lensman and Balrog awards. In addition to his illustration work, he designed concepts for toys and themed restaurants. From 1973 to 1980, he worked for Hallmark Cards, Inc and Current Inc., designing greeting cards, jigsaw puzzles, wrapping paper, stationery, and books.
